

WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

The season prior to any World Championship, the following BIFFA or UKFFA Championships will be qualifying events for the World Championship, and up to three other events (if required) to be decided by the championship committee.

Championship of the British Isles, Northern Championships, Southern Championships, Scottish Championships and Inland Championships.

The overall result from each event shall be used to construct a points table for eligible helm's, points being awarded using the low point system, 50% of the events rounded up shall count. Those helms with the lowest points shall be invited to take up the places available to the BIFFA. Any places still available after this process will be awarded based on the position that subsequent helms finish in the above table i.e. awarded to the next highest placed helm in strict order of placing, ties will be broken.

Please note points are awarded to the helm and not the boat, points cannot be carried forward. To be eligible a helm must be a member of British Isles Flying Fifteen Association otherwise known as The UK Flying Fifteen Association (with no monies owing to the association), who does not already qualify for a place automatically. Solely for the purposes of calculating the qualifying points table, any ineligible helm will be removed from the championship results before they are used for the qualifying table.
